Pupil Guidance for Year 11 Summer Examinations 2024



- Study leave is from Thursday 2 May to Friday 17 May.
- GCSE Unit examinations start from Wednesday 8 May.
- Internal examinations begin on Thursday 2 May.

You only attend School when you have an examination during this period of study leave. At all other times you remain at home to prepare and revise.

Year 11 GCSE Unit Examinations 2024

Outside of the study leave period (which is from Thursday 2nd May to Friday 17 May), a normal School Timetable is in operation throughout May and June. Pupils attend classes as timetabled and are entitled to the following study leave:

- If their GCSE Unit examination is in the afternoon, pupils may study at home in the morning.
- If a GCSE Modular examination is in the morning, pupils then return to normal timetabled class after the examination.
- If a pupil has both a morning and afternoon GCSE Modular Examination on the same day, they may revise in a designated study area after their morning examination.
- 1. You must not bring the following items to any examination: mobile phone, mobile device, Apple Watch or equivalent. You must clear your desk of all books, materials and pencil cases for the start of each examination.
- 2. Only water in clear, unlabelled plastic bottles is allowed. Pencil cases must be clear plastic.
- 3. All of your examinations, both internal and external, will take place in the William Moles Hall. External unit examinations will start at the designated time. Where there is a short Internal Examination, you can revise first and start the examination later in the Session so that all Internal Examinations finish at the end of each Session. You should have suitable material for revision. If you are entitled to extra time, you will be allowed to start Internal Examinations earlier in the Session. The Internal Examination Session times are as follows:

- 4. Lunch can be taken in the Dining Centre as normal.
- 5. Normal classes resume on **Monday 20 May** for pupils in Year 11.
